The Unanswered Question is a musical work by American composer Charles Ives. Originally paired with Central Park in the Dark as Two Contemplations in 1908, The Unanswered Question was revised by Ives in 1930–1935. As with many of Ives' works, it was largely unknown until much later in his life, and was not performed until 1946.

The Unanswered Question (. Ives, Charles. ) This work is likely not in the public domain in the US (due to first publication with the required notice after 1924, plus renewal or "restoration" under the GATT/TRIPS amendments), nor in the EU and those countries where the copyright term is life+70 years. However, it is public domain in Canada (where IMSLP is hosted) and in other countries (China, Japan, S. Korea) where the copyright term is life+50 years.

Ives composed the "The Unanswered Question" circa 1906. He also made revisions to the work some time around 1930-35. The revised version (also known as Version 2), became the most well known version. The premiere performance of "The Unanswered Question" (Version 2) occurred on May 11, 1946.

## **Charles Ives "The Unanswered Question" Notes**

The Unanswered Question is one of the Ives' most familiar and admired works. Because it's so familiar you might do a double-take when you hear it on Track 5. The CD booklet says the performance uses the 1934 Peermusic edition (which I believe was reprinted by Southern Music in 1953).
